### KEYNOTE SPEAKER Ambassador Daniel Kurtzer

Daniel C. Kurtzer is the Professor of Middle East Policy Studies at Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs. During a 29-year career in the U.S. Foreign Service, Ambassador Kurtzer served as the U.S. Ambassador to Israel and as the U.S. Ambassador to Egypt.

He was also a speechwriter and member of Secretary of State George Shultz's Policy Planning Staff; and served as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Near Eastern Affairs and as Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Intelligence and Research.

Co-author of two books on Arab-Israeli Peace, Kurtzer served as a member of Secretary of State John Kerry's Foreign Affairs Policy Board and previously served as an advisor to the bipartisan Iraq Study Group.

Ambassador Kurtzer received a B.A. from Yeshiva University and a Ph.D. from Columbia University.
