Prof. Rob Goldston

Robert J. Goldston is a Professor Astrophysics at Princeton University. received his B.A. in Physics from Harvard University, and his Ph.D. in Astrophysics from Princeton University. He was director of the Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory (PPPL), 1997 – 2009. He is Associated Faculty with the Program on Science and Global Security, and was acting director in Spring 2015.

Goldston won the American Physical Society "Excellence in Plasma Physics" award in 1988, . the Fusion Power Associates Leadership Award in 2001, and the Nuclear Fusion "Most Outstanding Paper" prize for 2012. He was named a "Leading Global Thinker" by Foreign Policy Magazine in 2014.

He has participated in CFPA Candidate Briefings as a nuclear weapon expert, and was speaker at two CFPA Membership Renewal Gatherings. He serves on the board of the Council for a Livable World.

Sister Simone Campbell

Sister Simone Campbell has served as Executive Director of NETWORK since 2004. She is a religious leader, attorney and poet with extensive experience in public policy and advocacy for systemic change.

Sister Simone was also instrumental in organizing the "Nuns on the Bus" tour of nine states. Simone has frequently been featured in the national and international media, including appearances on 60 Minutes, The Colbert Report, and The Daily Show with Jon Stewart. She has received numerous awards, including a "Franklin D. Roosevelt Four Freedoms Award" and the "Defender of Democracy Award" from the international Parliamentarians for Global Action. In addition, she has been the keynote or featured speaker at numerous large gatherings, including the 2012 Democratic National Convention.

Richard Moody

Richard Moody is a former fighter pilot who served in the US Navy and the Royal Navy, and he was a former Top Gun instructor. He has undergone a transformation in his life and has become an ardent peace activist with CFPA, as well as a practicing Quaker.

About 20 years ago, he joined the Coalition for Peace Action in Princeton, New Jersey, and has been a Quaker since. He is now very active in the name of Peace worldwide and works continuously to reduce US militarism and the death and destruction which is being carried out by the USA, and other countries, around the world. His volunteering abroad has included teaching in the Peruvian Andes and in the Black Townships in Cape Town and working in a Syrian Refugee Camp in Greece.
