Unmanned: America's Drone Wars

Unmanned: America's Drone Wars is a film is by Robert Greenwald and Brave New Foundation. Greenwald investigates the impact of U.S. drone strikes at home and abroad through more than 70 separate interviews, including a former American drone operator who shares what he has witnessed in how own words. Throughout *Unmanned*, interviews are interspersed with never-before-seen footage from tribal regions in Pakistan to humanize those who have been impacted by our drone policy.

Nick Mottern has worked as a reporter, researcher, writer and political organizer the last 30 years. While in the US Navy, he was in VietNam in 1962-63. He graduated from Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism in 1966, and has worked as a reporter for the Providence (RI) Journal and Evening Bulletin, a researcher and writer for a US Senate Committee. He visited a number of African nations and war zones in Eritrea, Ethiopia and Mozambique as well as Israel and the West Bank. He manages www.KnowDrones.com. He was director of the 2012 national Know Drones Tour and in 2013 was an organizer of a national campaign to stop drone wars and surveillance.
