Can America become a peacemaker again?

From Taiwan, to the Middle East, to Ukraine, the United States retains strong influence. But not as a peacemaker. Increasingly, America's militarized foreign policy has led the US to take sides, get entangled in foreign conflicts, and negate its ability to play the role of a mediator or peacemaker. What are the roots of this shift in America's approach to the world? Given Russia's illegal invasion of Ukraine and China's rise, can the US revert to a more peaceful foreign policy?

Dr. Parsi is currently Executive Vice President of the Quincy Institute. He is a dynamic and deeply informed speaker and writer on a host of peace and international relations issues.

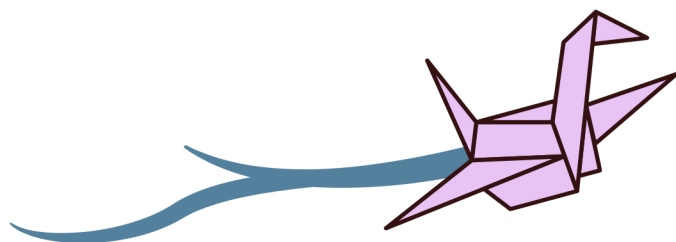
